Who's ready to walk in New Zealand and Australia? A unique set of circumstances will allow you to travel down under for three separate events in 10 days. Two International Marching League events will be held on consecutive weekends in March. The Rotorua Walking Festival, New Zealand, is March 15-17, 2024. IML and IVV credit distances include 10, 20, 30 and 42K. March 22-24 is the Aussie Peace Walk in Canberra, Australia. Distances for IML and IVV credit include 11, 12, 21,24 and 42K. Also happening in Canberra prior to the Aussie Peace Walk is the IVV Congress of Delegates Assembly March 19-21. This will be my first time attending the IVV Congress of Delegates.



2023 Q3 PARTICIPATION

Clubs are requested to do their best to get their 2023 Q3 YRE/SE participation entered by October 15th. This is to facilitate the prompt transition to <u>my.ava.org</u> system from legacy ESR system for YRE participation feature and the shutdown on the Legacy ESR system hardware in the main office.

Microsoft is discontinuing support for Windows Server 2012 R2 which is the Operating System (OS) used by the Legacy ESR in October. This means there will be no further security updates for this OS. Continuing to use the Legacy ESR after October 15th increases the chance that this system could be compromised/exploited based on new unmatched security vulnerabilities.


