## **BOARD CHAIR'S MESSAGE**

Every little bit you give helps us reach our goal. It's important that you give, not how much you give. I am sure you know there are many ways you can give. Of course, you can give during the online portion September 18-19 from 6pm the 18th to 6pm the 19th. I am sure you have seen the ways AVA can benefit if we have a big turnout during the online portion.

But you can also give during the whole week, the whole month of September and through the entire month of October to be counted as a Big Give donor. Please encourage your club to donate. The hotel rates range from \$154.00++ - \$94.50++, breakfast is included.

## NEW AVA MEMBERSHIP PROGRAM AND WALK APPLICATION COMING IN 2025!

Members of the Walk Application (App) Committee and the Membership Committee have been working hard for several months to roll out a new membership program and a walk application in 2025.

The AVA board of directors recently approved continuation of the planning process for the Walk App. The next steps are development of the requirements document and issuance of a Request for Quotes to parties interested in developing the Walk App. The AVA board of directors will approve the contract for the developer. Start-up costs for the App development are \$100,000.

In September, the board will discuss a new membership program proposal from the Membership Committee. Details of the New Membership Model will be shared with clubs after the Board has been briefed, and recommended changes are made by the committee.

## FREE CLUB SUPPORT WITH GRAPHIC DESIGN - QUICK RESPONSE NEEDED!

If your club needs help with graphic design to create a new logo, or social media graphics, or maybe even a T-shirt or brochure design for an upcoming event, we can help! The AVA, in partnership with Austin Peay State University, may be able to provide your club with a sponsored student intern who can assist you with your graphic design needs. There is a cost of \$200 that the AVA will pay on behalf of your club.

If accepted, you will be assigned one or two students to help you with your design work from September 17 – November 26. During this time, you will have to meet with the student twice on Zoom (no phone call) and then follow up occasionally as needed. Follow up meetings may be a phone call.

Please include on the form under Use of Funds your list of jobs that you would like for the student to complete. You must have two jobs for the student to complete. If you have the two jobs in mind, please send just those two. If you have more than two jobs, then list your top 5 jobs and we will help you decide on which 2 the student can create. If you only have one job, and need help thinking of a second, please see the attached document. It may give you ideas as it shows examples from our students in the past. Reminder, no websites, or magazines.

Also, with the VA and other places where there are Veterans. Many of these Veterans may have been on volksmarches in Europe, Asia, or even in the USA. They may have forgotten about the fun they had on walks, the people they knew, and the sights they saw. Remind them! Get these cards out. Drop some of the 2025 AVA Convention cards here and there too.



I found out on 25 July through my American Legion District newsletter, the Legion and VA are involved in "Grouper". I was able to register myself for my club's upcoming traditional event and our local YRW through their site. It didn't mention "Strider" as I have been advised through AVA discussions. ## WANTED -- AVA SPECIAL PROGRAM PROPOSALS FOR 2026

Does your club have an idea for a new AVA Special Program they would sponsor? One current Special Program will end on 12/31/25 so the Programs Committee will be looking for one new Special Program to begin on January 1, 2026.

Do you know of a theme that would generate interest from a historical, cultural, educational, or scenic beauty perspective that has not previously been a Special Program? Are there major or intriguing American anniversaries occurring in 2026? Now would be the time to put your creative ideas and imagination to work. Talk with club members on walks as some have additional interests outside walking (yes, it does happen) and those other activities may generate ideas. Check your community calendars for local celebrations that are applicable across all states. Add "Brainstorming Special Programs" to the club's meeting agenda and solicit ideas at the meetings.

The AVA Special Program Policy limits new proposals for consideration, review and approval to just one AVA Board of Directors (BOD) Meeting per year which, is typically the first meeting of the calendar year (i.e. 2025). If the proposal is approved, then the Special Program begins January 1st of the following year (i.e. 2026). Approval at the first BOD meeting of the calendar year provides sufficient time for the sponsoring club, before the Special Program's start date, to submit articles to TAW and the Checkpoint describing the new program, obtain booklets/awards and update the AVA webpage and OSB with the new program information. Plus, it allows the clubs across the country to understand the details of the new Special Program, review their current trails or develop new routes to include the qualifiers of the new program.

The AVA Special Program policy is on the AVA website (ava.org) and can be found by selecting the "Clubs Only" menu item at the top of the page, then select "Club Resources" followed by "Club Policies." Scroll down to the middle of the webpage and select "AVA Policy Manual." Scroll down to section named "IVV Volkssporting Events" and click on "AVA Special Programs & Club Challenges." You may also go to the Special Programs policy by using the link: <u>Special Programs and Club Challenges (rev. 01.31.23 wck).pdf (ava.org)</u>

The Special Program proposal includes a complete description of the Special Program theme, a signed copy of the Special Program agreement, a budget based on the income and expenses for 100 books, a sample Special Program booklet and a color sample and size of the proposed award. The proposal needs to be received by the Special Programs Chair by November 1st, 2024. This deadline allows time for the Committee, during the busy holiday season at the end of the year, to review the proposal, communicate any concerns or suggestions to the club for revisions, and then review the submission of the final proposal and associated items. Presentations of the Committee's recommended Special Programs for approval are typically presented at the first BOD Meeting of the calendar Year (i.e. 2025).

## UPDATE FOR AVA SPECIAL PROGRAMS REDEMPTION PROCEDURE

In today's environment, reducing costs and promoting sustainability is on everyone's radar. With the recent USPS postage increase, the need to re-evaluate the current method of redeeming Special Program books became a major topic at a July Special Programs Committee meeting. The current method entails the Special Program participant sending their completed book by snail mail to the Special Program POC for verification of all the qualifiers. The POC, after verification of the qualifiers, returns the completed book and the Special Program reward item to the participant by snail mail. This process includes costs for envelopes, copying, postage and maybe even transportation costs to and from the Post Office for both the participant and POC.



To minimize costs and promote sustainability the modified procedure for the redemption of Special Program books, <u>effective immediately</u>, will be as follows: 1 - Scan or take pictures of each page of your completed Special Program book; and 2 - e-Mail the images to the Special Program POC. Your Special Program reward item will then be mailed to you by snail mail. So, no postage costs for the participant and budgeted or minimally increased postage costs for the POC, no copying and paper costs for the participant since the original Special Program book is retained by the participant, no worrying about lost books in the mail, and faster submission of the completed Special Program book and turnaround for the reward item. Win, win for both!

The Committee realizes that not everyone owns or has access to an All-In-One (also known as a multi-function) printer that can scan for this new procedure. For Special Program participants in this situation, we ask that instead of sending the original Special Program book you make a copy of it and send the copy via snail mail to the POC. In return, you will receive only the Special Program reward item. The copy of the Special Program book will not be returned as you have the original.

Check the AVA Special Program web page to see if the Special Program book you are redeeming is participating in these new electronic procedures. If they are, there will be a one-line statement "Completed Book Redemption by Email is supported via the email, [POC's email]" at the bottom of the Special Program paragraph.

Special AVA pricing is only \$957.85 per person on an inside cabin, based on double occupancy.



### **FINANCIAL**

If your club's fiscal year ends on 6-30-24, it is time to file your 990 E-Postcard, Annual Financial Report (AFR), and update your club officers. Both documents are to be submitted to the national office before the November 15, 2024 deadline.
